# GED® UNDERAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students who have filed a formal declaration of intent to terminate school enrollment can take the GED® Test after reaching the age of 16. The school district no longer requires underage candidates to pass the GED® Ready practice tests.

## Guidelines for Underage Prospective Students Planning to Enroll in a GED® Preparation Course:

### STEP 1:

- Students must be 16 or 17 years old
- Create a GED® account [GED.com](https://GED.com)
- Provide proof of **withdrawal from high school**.
- Submit a formal **Letter of Intent**, which must be notarized.
- Complete the **Underage Waiver Application**, which must be typed and notarized.

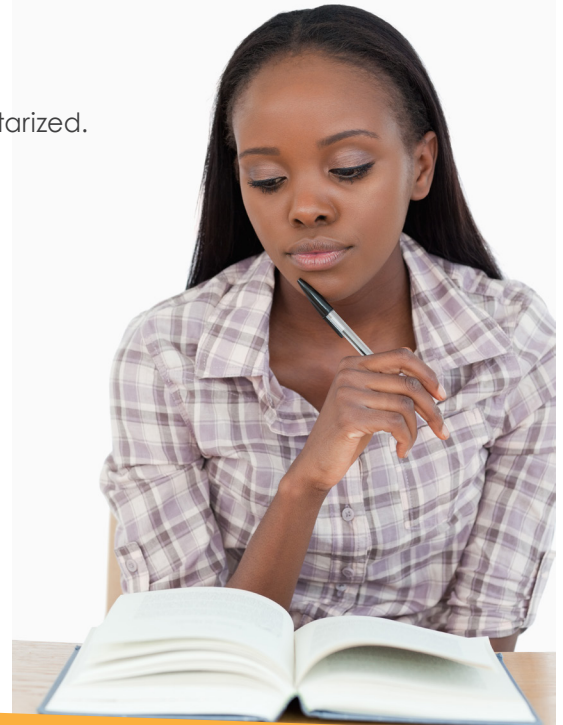
