## PATIENT CARE TECHNICIAN

### Course Content:

This program prepares the student to function as a multi-skilled healthcare worker who, under the direction and supervision of a Registered Nurse, carries out the essential basic bedside patient care functions. The Patient Care Technician comes in direct contact with the patient in the performance of his/her assigned duties.

Students also receive supplementary training in 12-lead EKG, basic phlebotomy techniques and restorative skills.

600 Hours (approximately 6 months full-time)

- Physical exam – Annual
- Tuberculin (PPD) 2-Step (X2) or Chest X-ray – Annual
- Drug Testing– by Authorized Lab Only

- Compliance Tracking Subscription (Approved Vendor Only)

### Immunizations:

- Vaccine (Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis) (DTaP or TDaP)
- MMR Vaccine Series (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) (X2) or Titer
- Hepatitis B Vaccine Series (X3) or Titer or Authorized Declination Form
- Varicella Vaccine (X2) or Titer
- Influenza Vaccine (Flu Shot)

### Industry Certification & State Credential Exams:

Students will be prepared to take an approved state and/or nationally recognized industry certification or licensure exam in their field of study. Exam costs are additional; however, you may qualify for reimbursement of your exam cost(s) upon passing. See your program counselor/ advisor for more information.

### College Credit Transfer Opportunity Credential Exams:

Upon completion of the program, you may be eligible to receive FREE associate degree transfer credits from Broward College or another state college.
