Course Content:

The Manufacturer Specific Automotive Service Technology (Toyota T-TEN) program is specific to Toyota/Lexus products using Toyota/Lexus automotive vehicles, trainers, parts, tools and curriculum materials. Instruction includes practical classroom applications and a paid internship experience at a Toyota/Lexus dealership under the supervision of a Certified Toyota/Lexus Technician and the Program Teacher-Coordinator to achieve factory certification. Instruction also coincides with the eight (8) areas of professional technician certification recognized by the ASE Education Foundation.

Today's technicians must possess advanced skills in math, communications, electronics and the ability to diagnose complex problems. This advanced program is an intense training and academic program provided by ATC in partnership with Toyota Motor North America, Inc. (TMNA), Southeast Toyota Distributors, local Toyota and Lexus dealers, and Broward College.
